-DESCRIPTION-

Type and Purpose A specialist module which introduces the student to the basic trim requirements of p.s.v.'s, rail vehicles, aircraft, private cars and commercial vehicles.

Learning Outcomes The student should:-
1. know the methods of joining trimming and filling materials;
2. select and use suitable tools and methods in trimming components;
3. use safe practices and procedures in trim workshop situations.

Content/ Context Corresponding to the Learning Outcomes:
1. methods of joining and fixing materials by:
(a) sewing;
(b) adhesives;
(c) tacks;
(d) staples.
2. the functions and uses of hand tools, powered hand tools such as foam cutters, cloth cutters, fixing tools.
Methods of trimming seats, backs, arm rests, head rests, panels etc.

3. safe working practice when trimming.

Use of protective clothing.

This module should be taught in a practical situation where students can work on practical exercises involving:

- (a) practical cutting and forming of filling materials using adhesives;
- (b) attaching filling materials to trim components;
- (c) fitting and joining covering materials;
- (d) covering seating and trim components.
