-DESCRIPTION-

Type and Purpose A specialist module (1/2) which introduces the student to the repair and restoration of damaged trim components.

Learning Outcomes The student should:

1. select an appropriate method of repairing damaged trim components;
2. remove and refit damaged components;
3. complete repairs to damaged components;
4. use safe working practices.

Content/ Context Corresponding to the Learning Outcomes:

1. methods of repairing and restoring damaged trim;
Factors influencing selection of methods of repair.
2. methods of fixing trim components. Methods of removing and refitting trim components and materials;
3. trim repair procedures applicable to a range of trim materials and forms of damage;

4. safe working practice applicable to tools, equipment and work areas.

Suggested Learning and Teaching Approaches	<p>This module should be presented in a practical situation with the technology covered at appropriate times during a range of practical assignments.</p> <p>Students should complete practical assignments requiring them to complete repairs on a range of damaged trim components involving various methods of repair to a range of materials.</p>
