(c) Gianfranco mentions the work his parents did and his own future job. Give details. **2 points**

- His parents had/owned a tobacconist's (shop)/were tobacconists/they work in/own a tobacconist's.
- He's studying/he'd like to be a Spanish teacher.

NB: "he wants to help his parents in the future" – transfer mark to d(ii)

(d) (i) What does Gianfranco like to do in his spare time? **1 point**

- Read (motorcycle) magazines/reads about motorbikes/looks at (motorcycle) magazines.

(ii) What is he looking forward to doing when he starts working? Mention **two** things. **2 points**

- Buying/getting a motorbike.
- Helping his parents.
