National Qualifications update – Geology

The following items are included:

- 1 National Assessment Bank items – Intermediate 1 and Higher
- 2 Learning and teaching materials – Intermediate 2 and Higher
- 3 External Assessment Reports

1 National Assessment Bank items – Intermediate 1 and Higher

SQA will shortly commence work on revising and updating the NAB items for two Geology Units, one at Intermediate 1 and one at Higher. The Units due to have new NABs produced are:

D245 10 Geology, People and Environment (Intermediate 1)
D8XK 12 Minerals and Rocks (Higher)

Each Unit will have 3 new NAB items produced to replace the existing suite for that Unit. We anticipate that the revised NABs will be published in Autumn this year. Centres will be alerted when the new NABs are available to download from SQA's secure site.

2 Learning and teaching materials – Intermediate 2 and Higher

We are currently working on the production of exemplar classroom exercises for Geology Intermediate 2 and Higher. We hope to be able to publish these materials in time for the start of the coming session. More details will be provided as soon as possible.

3 External Assessment Reports

The External Assessment Reports for the diet 2010 examinations in Geology have been uploaded to the relevant subject pages for each level of Geology on SQA's website. Centre staff responsible for delivering Geology, and those who plan to begin delivery, are advised to study these reports as they contain useful information on the strengths and weaknesses in candidates' approach to assessment in this subject, as well as advice to centres on improving candidate performance.
