'We found out that Hannah had a heart murmur when she was six weeks old,' explained Isabel. 'She was referred to Yorkhill just after her first birthday to be examined by specialists. Within a few weeks, Hannah was having open heart surgery to repair a faulty valve and holes in her heart.'

'The staff were wonderful during our time on the ward, and on our subsequent clinic visits over the next 19 years. These dedicated professionals deal with children and families when they are ill, stressed and vulnerable — and they do it with care and patience every working day.'

Hannah, now 24, lives life to the full — and has gone from strength to strength since her operation. She has been a competitive swimmer, played football, volleyball and softball, still plays tennis and ran her first half marathon in the spring.

It is thanks to Yorkhill that she, and other young people like her, are living normal lives.
