4. Many thanks to all those who were involved in writing and vetting the considerable amount of National Assessment Bank material which had to be revised and replaced as a result of the review.
5. SQA is keen to expand examining team membership for Gaelic subjects. Please contact SQA if you are interested in marking/setting/vetting/panel work. The area will require more teachers as the workload expands.
6. Subject summary grids for Gaelic (Learners) and Gàidhlig Courses have been produced which illustrate (on one A4 page) the contents of each Course at each level. A copy of each is attached as an appendix to this letter and is in the process of being posted on SQA's website (**www.sqa.org.uk**).
