Air Travel: An Introduction (DF6M 12)

I shall be grateful if you will draw attention to the contents of this letter to the teacher/lecturer responsible for the delivery of the Travel and Tourism programme in your centre.

I refer to the Travel and Tourism update letter issued in July 2005, which gave advance notice of amendments to the above Unit and associated NAB. Minor revision to provide for the inclusion of e-ticketing in the outcomes and performance criteria have now been completed. The revision relates to 'Outcome 4: performance criteria b)' which has been reworded. Previously the performance criteria stated that 'automated tickets are interpreted in accordance with IATA requirements'. This has now been modified to read 'Entries are confirmed for automated or other tickets in accordance with IATA requirements'. The practical exercises linked to the evidence requirements for this Outcome have also been revised in line with this change. Following on from these changes, the support notes within the Unit specification dealing with guidance on content and context and approaches to assessment have also been amended to reflect this revision. The change for content and context is in bullet point 6, and that for Assessment in bullet points 5, 11 and 13. This amended Unit has now replaced the previous version in the NQ Search on SQA's website, and is referred to as 'version 4 August 2005' in the footer at the bottom of page one of the Unit specification.

The NAB for the Unit is also being amended as part of this update and a revised version will shortly be available on the secure section of SQA's website. Centres will receive notification that this revised NAB has been posted on the website in the regular 'NAB Update' e-mail.
