I am writing to you as a centre that currently offers or has previously offered SVQs in Accounting. This letter is a reminder of what is available to centres from SQA. I hope you find this useful.

In addition, I would be very grateful if you would complete the short questionnaire attached and return it to SQA using the pre-paid envelope by Friday 11 September 2009.

SQA re-accredited the above SVQs in summer 2008 when the agreement for joint certification of the SVQs with the Association of Accounting Technicians (AAT) came to an end. Candidates can be entered for these SVQs until 31 July 2010. Candidates will be required to complete the SVQ level 2 by 31 July 2012 and the SVQ level 3 by 31 July 2013.

The current Assessment Strategy, Assessor's Guidelines, National Occupational Standards (NOS) and blank recording forms (to record candidate progress) can be downloaded from SQA's website ([www.sqa.org.uk](http://www.sqa.org.uk)). A bank of assessments to support the independent assessment element of the SVQs is available from the secure area of SQA's website. I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that the independent assessment element(s) of the SVQs can be offered to candidates 'on demand'. As such, I hope that centres will find this helpful in terms of planning assessment for candidates.

Entry charges for SVQs are as follows:

SVQ Level 2 – £49.25  
SVQ Level 3 — £54.00

As you may be aware the NOS for Accountancy and Finance were recently revised by the Financial Services Skills Council (FSSC). The revised standards can be downloaded from FSSC's website — [www.fssc.org.uk](http://www.fssc.org.uk). These will be used to inform the development of future qualifications in Scotland.
