Standard Grade

Titles/levels of Standard Grade qualifications verified

Foundation, General and Credit: Practical Abilities

General comments

All centres produced evidence from candidates which had clear explanations and were relevant to the experiences covered. Obvious care and attention had been given to producing suitable evidence from all aspects of the Course. The evidence clearly demonstrated the depth and diversity of experiences available to the candidates.

Centres are producing very good evidence clearly explaining why grades had been achieved. The use of photographs is very common and they give a clear understanding of the role the individual candidate has taken in the experience. The comments from the responsible members of staff were clear and explained the amount of support the individual candidates required therefore justifying the final grade. Evidence was well presented and labelled.

Areas of good practice/areas for improvement

Evidence produced from a variety of experiences supports the final grade.

Photographs are well used to explain how the individual candidate was part of the experience and allows the Verifier to understand why a grade has been awarded.

The comments from the member of staff responsible support the final grade from the centre.

Specific areas for improvement

Generally, the self-evaluation by the candidate could be improved. The review of their role is rarely clear or specific about the experience they have completed.
