

How we marked it

Technical marking – against a rubric that is pre-agreed.

Report – Look for set points on a checklist but there is a holistic element so second marking is required.



How we marked it

Use a rubric for structure but use a round table marking where all the papers are discussed and marked in a team environment

How we marked it

Again, as many people as available to sit in as this is a passion piece and does not work well with a rubric.

However, could grade on a checklist style level of research and information.

Responses to questions helped to ensure own work

Must have the project title in early so that we could research too.

 Case used a charity shop allowing for a link for all the papers to talk about especially Professional considerations in accounting.


HOW WE USED ROLE PLAY

For topic like interviewing Create a job in the charity shop Have the students then prepare and post the job Have CV's given to the students Then have them interview for the post

Shop stock take was done


Reflected in class
