- **The IP1 Approval Form** can be found on the Baccalaureate pages of SQA's website <http://www.sqa.org.uk/baccalaureates> under the heading 'Approval and Quality Assurance'. Centres delivering both the Science and Languages Baccalaureates should complete a separate IP1 for each award. Approval is required to enable centres to enter candidates in November. Centres approved in 2009/10 are not required to renew this approval. If you require advice on the completion of the IP1 please contact Lorna Grant.
- **Candidate Entries:** Candidates sitting the Scottish Baccalaureate award should be entered for both the Baccalaureate and the Interdisciplinary Project. Details of entry codes are on the News page of the Baccalaureate section of SQA's website but details of these codes are as follows:

Candidates doing the Interdisciplinary Project as a stand alone unit should only be entered for the Interdisciplinary Project.
