## Plant Operations and Controlling Lifting Operations NVQ/SVQ Qualifications and Units

This assessment strategy will also apply where plant or lifting units, sourced from the Plant Operations or Controlling Lifting Operations' suite of units, are used in other QCF NVQs and SVQs. (Please note that Assessment Strategy for Construction and the Built Environment – Plant and Lifting Operations is still under review and will be issued as soon as possible.)

## Guidance on the Assessment of QCF NVQ Units

The information below should help awarding organisations incorporate relevant parts of the assessment strategy principles' requirements in their documentation for construction and built environment – QCF NVQs. The following guidance is strongly recommended for adoption by awarding organisations in their assessment methodology.

  - 2.3 'List the current Health and Safety Executive top ten safety risks' should be assessed as 'List the current <u>common</u> safety risks'.
  - 2.4 'List the current Health and Safety Executive top five health risks' should be assessed as 'List the current <u>common</u> health risks
- All CITB QCF NVQ units Assessment Criteria 1.4
  - 1.4 'State why and when health and safety control equipment, identified by the principles of <u>protection</u>' should be assessed as 'State why and when health and safety control equipment, identified by the principles of <u>prevention</u>'
