Monitor Wrapping and Labelling of Products in Food Manufacture

Unit Summary

This Unit is about planning and co-ordinating the wrapping and labelling of food and drink products. It covers developing a plan that uses sufficient resources, confirming availability of materials, tools etc and checking that your plan complies with all legal and standard operational requirements.

This Unit is for you if you work and drink manufacturing operations and you have responsibilities for the planning, implementation and monitoring of wrapping and labelling operations of food and rink products. You may be a team leader, line manager or supervisor.

In order to be assessed as competent you must demonstrate to your assessor that you can consistently perform to the requirements set out below. Your performance evidence must include at least one observation by your assessor.

1	 (a) Monitor consistently the progress against production targets. (b) Provide supervision and support to your team to resolve difficulties and ensure targets are met. (c) Report difficulties outside of your area of responsibility to relevant personnel. (d) Keep record of wrapping labelling operate accurate and complete, and store for easy retrieval. (e) Take prompt corrective action where technical or material faults threaten the operation and achievement of targets. (f) Follow legal and standard operational requirements in wrapping and labelling operation. (g) Manage risk effectively and ensure the workplace is hazard free. (h) Monitor the wrapping and labelling of products and ensure that they are done correctly, using appropriate materials and methods for each product. 	This means you must manage two types of risk eg physical danger to persons, equipment damage, material damage, product contamination, incorrect waste disposal, and incorrect storage.	

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Evidence of Performance

- observation
- written and oral questioning
- evidence from company systems (eg Food Safety Management System)
- reviewing the outcomes of work
- checking any records of documents completed
- checking accounts of work that the candidate or others have written
