(b) Demonstrate knowledge of the legal, safety and operating requirements of the vehicle and the load before driving. (c) Confirm that the correct driving licence for the vehicle being driven is held. (d) Check their own fitness to drive safely in compliance with all relevant legal, safety and operating requirements. (e) Identify any problems in complying with relevant legal, safety and operating requirements and take appropriate action. 	<p>Evidence of identifying the legal, safety and operating requirements for the vehicle and the load in accordance with workplace procedures.</p>	
<p>2</p> <p>Protect the vehicle and load from security risks</p> <p>This means you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Demonstrate the organisational security procedures to the vehicle and load in different locations. (b) Demonstrate the correct emergency procedures. (c) Report any theft or damage according to organisational procedures. 	<p>Evidence of protecting the vehicle and load from security risks in accordance with workplace procedures.</p> <p>The need for simulation may result from consideration of safety, legislation, regulation, contingency and cost.</p>	

Evidence of Performance

Evidence of performance may employ examples of the following assessment:

- ◆ observation
- ◆ written and oral questioning
- ◆ evidence from company systems (eg Food Safety Management System)
- ◆ reviewing the outcomes of work
- ◆ checking any records of documents completed
- ◆ checking accounts of work that the candidate or others have written
