Standard CU18 Construct and maintain structures and surfaces(SQA Unit Code-F8DA 04)

Element CU18.2	Construct and maintain surfaces

Overview

This standard is concerned with constructing and maintaining structures and surfaces. Structures may be permanent or temporary, and could include: fences, walls, sheds and livestock holdings. Surfaces could include standing areas, container beds, roads and pathways.

Construction and maintenance will be carried out in accordance with instructions from your supervisor. 'Construction' is defined as creating a new structure or surface, or replacing an existing structure or surface. 'Maintenance' may be undertaken to maintain the effectiveness of the structure, or to increase its lifespan. Alternatively, 'maintenance' may be carried out to repair a structure or surface. In some cases, the distinction between construction and maintenance will need to be evaluated on a case by case basis.

The standard is designed to be appropriate for the operations using hand-held or pedestrian controlled power tools. There is no requirement within the standard to use chainsaws although this would be possible if you held the appropriate Certificate of Competence.

In this standard 'organic waste' may include for example, debris from plants, earth, woodchip. Whilst 'inorganic waste' may include, for example; plastic containers and plastic bags.

- 6. Use tools and equipment safely and correctly
- 7. Maintain health and safety during the work consistent with relevant legislation and codes of practice
- 8. Make the site as good as possible following **operations**, and dispose of any **waste** or unwanted materials correctly
