Overview

What this standard is about

This standard is about a driver's responsibility in relation to the load they are carrying and requirements relating to the collection and delivery of loads. It covers what a driver needs to do to make sure that their vehicle is suitable for the load to be carried and the documentation that they need to complete to comply with legal and organisational requirements during each driving duty.

This standard is relevant to drivers of goods vehicles and those who are responsible for goods vehicles within logistics organisations

 - P3 take appropriate action when there are problems with obtaining information on the **load, destination** or **schedule**
 - P4 identify any requirements for **loading** and/or **unloading**
 - P5 identify any requirements for monitoring the **load** during transport
 - P6 identify any requirements for timing the delivery or collection
 - P7 assess any recent information that could affect the **destination** and **schedule** being achieved
 - P8 communicate effectively with other people
 - P9 ensure your **vehicle** is suitable for the dimensions and weight of the **load**
 - P10 comply with **legal, safety and operating requirements** relating to the collection and delivery of loads

- K2 who from, and where to get information about the **load**
- K3 what type of information is required about the **destination** and **schedule**
- K4 what action to take if you are unable to obtain information about to the **load, destination** or **schedule**
- K5 what type of requirements there could be for **loading, unloading**, or monitoring the **load** during transport
- K6 what type of problems could occur with the **load** which would require monitoring
- K7 what type of requirements there could be for reaching the **destination**, and the timing of the delivery or collection
- K8 where to find recent information that could affect the **destination** and **schedule** being achieved, and how to use it
- K9 what type of problems could occur with the **destination** and **schedule**
- K10 how to communicate effectively with others
- K11 what the **legal, safety and operating requirements** are, relating to the collection and delivery of loads

Additional Information

Glossary

- **Destination:** delivery point, collection point
- **Legal, safety and operating requirements relevant to the collection and delivery of loads:** highway code, transport regulations, codes of practice, load restrictions, drivers' hours, working time directive
- **Load:** containers, liquids, goods, materials, livestock, ADR
- **Loading/unloading:** complete, partial, sequential
- **Schedule:** collection time, delivery time, stops
- **Vehicle:** the vehicle you normally drive, includes trailer when connected and ancillary equipment
