

## Overview

This standard is about processing arisings from treework operations.

Processing and disposal could include stacking, burning, burying, reducing, re-using or spreading.

Your work must conform to all relevant legislation and codes of practice when carrying out this work.

## Process arisings from treework operations

---

### Performance criteria

You must be able to:

1. assess the risks associated with the site and the proposed work
2. select and implement the appropriate working methods, in accordance with the assessed risks
3. select and use the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) for the work
4. select, prepare and use the appropriate tools and equipment, safely and effectively
5. prepare the arisings from treework operations in accordance with the specification, the site, relevant legislation and industry guidelines
6. process the arisings from treework operations appropriate to their condition, the specification and the site requirements
7. communicate with others and maintain affective team work
8. deal with any problems within your level of responsibility
9. follow the environmental good practice set by your organisation and the industry, and minimise environmental damage
10. ensure the site is left in a condition which meets environmental requirements, in accordance with the specification
11. maintain the health and safety of yourself and others, in accordance with relevant legislation

## Process arisings from treework operations

---

### Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

1. how to identify hazards and assess risks
2. how to interpret risk assessments
3. the selection, use and care of personal protective equipment (PPE)
4. the types of tools and equipment required and how to maintain and use these safely and effectively
5. different uses for the arisings including; burning, stacking, burying, spreading, further processing, re-use as another product
6. how to select the appropriate method of processing the arisings from treework operations
7. how to select the appropriate method of disposal or onward transport of the arisings from treework operations
8. how to comply with relevant legislation regarding disposal, transport and storage of the arisings from treework operations
9. the potential impact of your work on the environment and how this can be minimized
10. the importance of checking how well you worked with others to process arisings
11. the importance of checking how well you dealt with any problems when processing arisings
12. your responsibilities under relevant environmental, health and safety legislation and codes of practice
