The event focused on the cross curricular development of Literacy and Numeracy awards from a Key Stage 3 perspective.

Biography

Anne is Principal Officer for Key Stage 3 with specific responsibility for ICT assessment and development at Key Stage 3. Council for Curriculum, Assessment and Examinations in Northern Ireland (CCEA).

She has over 14 years experience teaching in a secondary school as well as two years as an Advisory Officer for Educational Technology in North Eastern Education and Library Board.
