Before you start to research you must select a brief and read the 'Instructions for candidates' which give details of the skills you must demonstrate and the type of evidence you must provide.

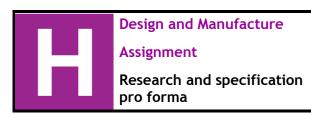
You should speak to your teacher or lecturer before you start if you are unclear about what is required for this assessment.

Produce the product design specification on the research and specification pro forma.

You must:

- ◆ Identify a retail environment in which the display stand will be used.
- ◆ Identify the items which the display stand will be required to hold.
- Identify additional issues required for the specification.
- Carry out primary and secondary research.
