For each item, read the English **once**, then read the Mandarin **twice**, with an interval of 1 minute between the two readings. On completion of the second reading of item number one, pause for the length of time indicated in brackets after the item, to allow the candidates to write their answers.

Where special arrangements have been agreed in advance to allow the reading of the material, those sections marked **(f)** should be read by a female speaker and those marked **(m)** by a male; those sections marked **(t)** should be read by the teacher.

(t) Item number one

You hear a news bulletin about a gap year for young people.

You now have one minute to study the questions for item number one.

You listen to Sophie who talks about her gap year in China.

- (f) 第一，這是了解中國傳統文化的好機會，第二，我可以練習我的中文，第三，我可以試試當老師。我媽媽一聽我的打算就對我說：“你千萬別去！”後來我告訴她我的想法，她想了想後說：“好吧，你要常給我發電子郵件啊。”
- (m) 那你覺得在中國農村的生活怎麼樣？
- (f) 我們志願者都住在當地人的家裡，每天跟他們一起吃飯。在我住的地方，有三個美國志願者和三個中國志願者。剛開始，我們都很不習慣農村的生活。最頭疼的是洗澡問題。你知道在農村，水不夠用，有時候水還不乾淨。我住的中國人家裡，地方不大，四個人住一個小房間，天氣又熱，所以經常睡不好。
- (m) 你習慣吃農村的東西嗎？
- (f) 很好啊，我特別喜歡吃農村的飯菜，因為吃的東西都非常新鮮，很好吃，比我在蘇格蘭吃的健康多了。而且農村的風景太美了，空氣很好，不像北京上海那些大城市，污染嚴重。
- (m) 你是在教小學還是中學？
- (f) 我們的學生是十一歲到十四歲，都是中學生。他們學習很努力，上課愛問問題。我非常喜歡我的學生，覺得他們很可愛。現在我才知道，當老師是多麼地不容易，不但要花很長時間準備上課的內容，而且要有耐心和愛心，關愛孩子。
- (m) 這個空檔年對你的將來有幫助嗎？
- (f) 對我的幫助太大了。不但讓我的經歷豐富了，而且讓我變得更獨立和自信。

Marking Instructions

These marking instructions have been provided to show how SQA would mark this specimen question paper.

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General marking principles for Higher Mandarin (Traditional) Listening

Always apply these general principles. Use them in conjunction with the detailed marking instructions, which identify the key features required in candidates' responses.

- (a) Always use positive marking. This means candidates accumulate marks for the demonstration of relevant skills, knowledge and understanding; marks are not deducted for errors or omissions.
- (b) If a candidate response does not seem to be covered by either the principles or detailed marking instructions, and you are uncertain how to assess it, you must seek guidance from your team leader.
- (c) Award a mark to each answer. Marks are not transferable between questions and the answers for each question must come from the item.
- (d) Award marks according to the accuracy and relevance of the candidate's answers. Award marks to candidates where the answer is accurate but expressed in their own words.
