



Core Skills, awarded in Scotland, cover a variety of broad skills and abilities that help people cope with a changing society. They are important in the workplace, and for life and learning generally, they help people put their knowledge into action in a flexible way - and they help people adapt their existing knowledge and skills to the demands of a new situation.

There are four levels of Core Skills: Access 3 (simple); Intermediate 1 (straightforward); Intermediate 2 (routine but with some complex features); Higher (complex).

The attached tables signpost the relevant Core Skills against each unit of competence within the Learning and Development Standards.

The letter in each box relates to the appropriate level of Core Skills.
