Centres are reminded that the dates for uplift of coursework material vary slightly from year to year. The following advance information may be helpful.

- ◆ 26 March 2007 (Standard Grade — Folio)
- ◆ 26 April 2007 (Advanced Higher — Dissertation)

With regard to submitted work, candidates should be encouraged to make and retain a copy of work prior to submission. Exceptionally, the return of submitted work may be requested. Requests should be made by the end of September of the year concerned. There is a charge for the return of work. Further details are available from SQA (telephone: 0131-561 6951).

**Advanced Higher**

As previously indicated, the list of authors and texts specified for Literary Study in Advanced Higher English for session 2005–2006 will continue for session **2006–2007** (and the 2007 examination).

New lists for Literary Study and Language Study will apply with regard to session **2007–2008** (and the 2008 examination). Details were issued to centres in June 2006.

**Higher Close Reading**

As indicated in August 2004, centres are asked to note that the passages set in examination papers for Close Reading in Higher English may be printed in columns (like a newspaper) or without columns (like the pages of a book). The examiners will decide on the format most suitable for each passage in any year. In addition, the questions on passages may be printed on a separate page (or pages) to accompany the paper containing the passages. Candidates should be made aware of the possibility of these formats.
