The units within the PDA are likely to be delivered in the following sequence:

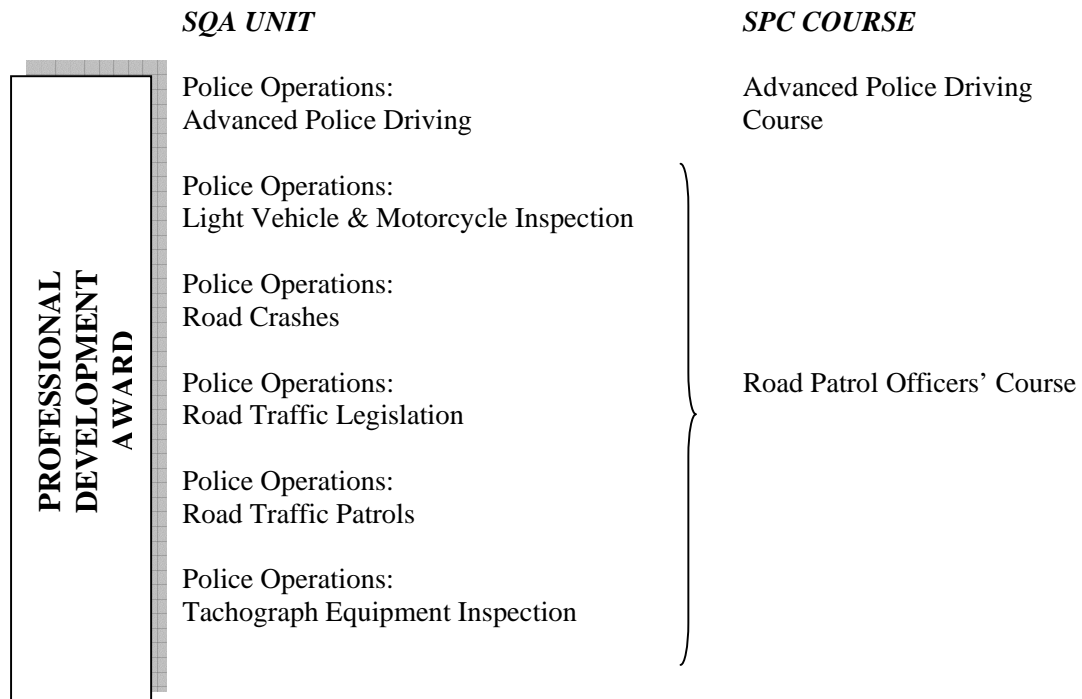
- Police Operations: Road Traffic Legislation
- Police Operations: Light Vehicle and Motorcycle Inspection
- Police Operations: Tachograph Equipment Inspection
- Police Operations: Advanced Police Driving
- Police Operations: Road Crashes
- Police Operations: Road Traffic Patrols

You will be awarded a Professional Development Award (PDA) accredited by the Scottish Qualifications Authority (SQA) when you have successfully completed all the units.

The main delivery methods for the PDA are:

- ◆ self study
- ◆ lectures
- ◆ facilitated classroom discussion
- ◆ practical demonstrations
- ◆ facilitated desk-top exercises

The diagram below shows the links between the PDA and the Advanced Police Driving and Road Patrol Officers' Courses.



Assessment for the above units, with the exception of Road Crashes and Road Traffic Patrols, will be carried out at the Scottish Police College during the Advanced Police Driving and Road Patrol Officers' courses. Units covering Road Crashes and Road Traffic Patrols will be completed at Force during operational duties and submitted to the Scottish Police College for assessment.
