- Friday 15 kg

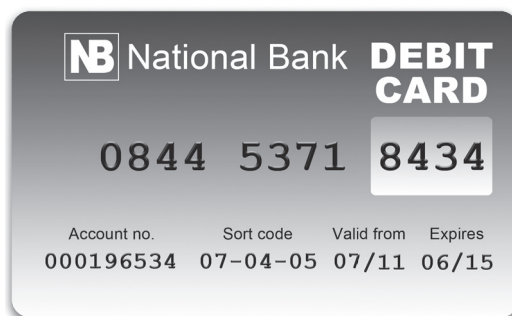
