

## Shine – an exhibition celebrating the creativity, determination and imagination of National 1 and 2 learners

### Exhibition rules

1. Entry to the exhibition is free and open to all learners resident in Scotland and undertaking qualifications at SCQF levels 1 and 2, in any Scottish school or further education college.
2. Entries may be individual or collaborative. **Three individual entries or one collaborative entry** may be submitted per centre.
3. Teachers must complete either an individual entry form or a group entry form for their learners. The form(s) should be submitted along with the work to SQA by **28 June 2018**.
4. All work must be labelled with the learner's name (or the names of all learners for group submissions), age at date of submission, school details, and teacher's name and e-mail contact details.
5. All works submitted will be retained permanently by SQA. SQA reserves the right to reproduce all works in printed and digital media for promotional and educational purposes. Data protection/permission forms issued by SQA will be completed by participating candidates.
6. Ideally, two-dimensional work should be placed between two protective layers of cardboard.
7. Ideally, three-dimensional pieces should be securely labelled with the candidate's name and centre number etc, and safely packed in a suitable box. Well lit, good quality photographs showing the 3D work from different angles can be sent in lieu of the original pieces.
8. All electronic submissions should be playable in Windows Media Player or standard DVD format. Storage devices must be clearly labelled showing centre and candidate details.
9. The selection panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
