02 Section 2: Comments on assessment

Assessment approaches

- Most centres visited had made items which met the criterion of eight construction techniques, with a minimum of two from a higher mark tariff.
- Some centres are still artificially limiting candidates by only marking construction techniques which add up to the total available for the quality of execution of construction techniques, 28 at National 5 and 30 at Higher.
- Centres are reminded that candidates can carry out techniques which add up to more than 28 or 30 marks, but can only be awarded a maximum of 28 or 30 marks respectively.
- Verifiers saw a wide range of items, with centres making effective use of the new patterns provided this year, as well as their own patterns.

Assessment judgements

- Most centre were making judgements in line with national standards. Where there were issues, it often stemmed from misidentification of construction techniques rather than assessors making incorrect judgements.
- Centres are advised to refer to the *Textile Construction Techniques* document, which can be found on the Understanding Standards website, for guidance.

03 Section 3: General comments

- Most centres felt a verification visit was a useful experience, with the opportunity to check against national standards being viewed as beneficial.
- Verifiers were pleased by the wide range of high quality items being made by candidates across both levels.
