## SECTION I—READING

Read the whole article carefully, and then answer **in English** the questions which follow it. In the article, two people give their points of view on whether everyone should go to university.

### 你真的需要上大學嗎？

**王明：你不需要上大學！**

如果你想做網絡的工作或者是一個商人，我認為你並不需要上大學。

我經常告訴我的朋友，如果五年前我就知道我現在想做什麼，我就不會去上大學了。但是那個時候我並不知道自己想要什麼，所以去上大學是一個不錯的選擇，因為大家都上大學！

我在大學的時候，學的是國際經濟學。畢業以後，我得到的是商業學位，有了這個學位，我很容易找到工作。可是，前年我開始做網絡工作，結果我大概只用了在大學裏學到的百分之五的東西。

有很多人認為應該上大學，因為大學裏學的東西，是中學裏學不到的，所以大家應該上大學。可是我認為，在大學學不到工作時候的“經驗”。因為我做的是網絡工作，所以我覺得工作經驗比大學裏學的東西更有用。如果我把讀大學四年的時間都花在網絡工作上，我將學到更多的東西。

另外，每個人的學習方法都不一樣，上大學不一定適合每個人。不過，我認為，如果你想在醫學界工作，或者想在國外工作，你就應該上大學，在那裏學習你需要的東西。其次，不上大學，不是說你不必學習了。我認為如果不上大學，自己學習會比較難。因為你必須獨立學習，沒有人告訴你應該做什麼，也很容易分心。

**李雲：每個人都應該上大學！**

有很多上大學的人，並不喜歡上學。他們覺得上學很無聊，也不知道畢業以後要做什麼。如果你怕大學畢業找不到工作，那麼沒上大學，找工作更難。

有些人認為不但每個人都應該上大學，而且大學應該是免費的。大學是一個從少年到成年人的重要時期。這四年裏，可能是你第一次離家獨立生活，跟新朋友一起逃課，跟室友吵架。我認為大學就是一個小社會，為你將來進入社會做準備。
