- 20 離開農場後，沃爾(Val)去了一個青年旅館當服務員。她認為通過這個工作，不但可以認識來自世界各地的人，同時也可以學到當地的風俗和文化，這樣也可以有更多不同的生活經歷。

她去了中國南方海邊的一個城市，在一個老人院幫忙照顧老人。她的工作包括陪老人散步、給老人講故事。在老人院工作，讓她瞭解到，雖然老人很孤獨，但是他們也有積極的生活態度。
