Monitor the transportation of supplies



Overview

This standard is about monitoring the transportation of supplies. It involves collating and analysing information with regard to the transportation of supplies. It also involves identifying problems, providing results of analysis, and making recommendations with regard to the transportation of supplies.

This standard is for supply chain practitioners. This could be, for example, in purchasing, freight logistics operations or transport management roles.

- 8. the communication methods used by your organisation
- 9. how to present the results of monitoring to colleagues
- 10. the relevant legal, regulatory and organisational requirements for the **transportation** of **supplies**

Glossary

Colleagues: permanent, temporary, agency staff, external

Supplies: any combination of goods or services that are procured, delivered or stored in the supply chain

Supply chain: procurement, purchasing and supply, logistics, transport, and operations management, within and between international boundaries

Transportation: the movement of supplies or resources internally or externally within own organisation, nationally or between international boundaries
