- ow 3. Refer to lines 29 to 30. 'I didn't feel like I was getting anywhere; then came Taylor.'
  - By referring to any part of this sentence, explain how it helps to provide a link between the writer's ideas at this point in the passage. [2 marks]
- ow 4. Refer to lines 42 to 60. Using your own words as far as possible, summarise what the writer already knew about Taylor Swift. You should make four key points in your answer. [4 marks]
- ow 5. Refer to lines 61 to 73. By referring to one example of language, explain how the writer makes [Braille page 3] it clear that Frankie is in control of the situation. [2 marks]
- ow 6. Refer to lines 75 to 104. Using your own words as far as possible, explain which aspects of the song appealed to the writer. You should make six key points in your answer. [6 marks]
- ow 7. Refer to lines 105 to 130. Using your own words as far as possible, explain how listening to Taylor Swift has affected the writer. You should make four key points in your answer. [4 marks]
- ow 8. Refer to lines 131 to 158. By referring to two examples of language, explain how the writer makes it clear that Taylor Swift is an exceptional artist. [4 marks]
- ow 9. Refer to lines 159 to 171. Select any expression from these lines and explain how it contributes to the passage's effective conclusion. [2 marks]
