Item 1

You hear a radio programme about Martinique, a tropical island which is part of France.

- * (a) How long is the coast of the island of Martinique? Choose the correct answer from the following. [1 mark]
 - A 30 km
 - B 300 km
 - C 3000 km
- (b) Why is Martinique the perfect place for a holiday? State **two** things. [2 marks]
- (c) What is the landscape of the island like? State any **two** features of the island. [2 marks]
- (d) The programme talks about the indoor market in the island's capital, Fort-de-France. What can you buy there? State any **two** things. [2 marks]
- (e) The presenter loves Martinique. What does she say about the island at the end of the programme? State **one** thing. [1 mark]

Item 2

A radio presenter interviews a young boy who lives in Martinique.

- (a) The boy, Cédric, lives in a village. Where is the village? **[1 mark]**
- (b) Cédric lives with his mum, dad and sisters. Who else also lives with them? **[1 mark]**
- * (c) When does the school day start and end for Cédric? Choose the correct answer from the following. **[1 mark]**
 - A Starts at 07:30 and ends at 13:00
 - B Starts at 08:00 and ends at 12:30
 - C Starts at 08:00 and ends at 14:30
- (d) Cédric talks about the food people eat on the island.
 - (i) His favourite food is 'le Colombo'. What does he say about it? State **two** things. **[2 marks]**
 - (ii) What does he suggest for dessert? State any **one** thing. **[1 mark]**
- (e) Cédric says that Martinique is perfect for people who love sport.
 - (i) You can go sailing or canoeing in Martinique. What other sports can you do? State **two** things. **[2 marks]**
 - (ii) What activity does Cédric recommend if you don't like sports? State **one** thing. **[1 mark]**
- (f) Cédric talks about the carnival, when there are orchestras and parades in the street. What does everyone do there? State any **three** things. **[3 marks]**
