This document contains a copy of the transcript for the Braille Question Paper Recording and is to be used by the reader, sound operator and/or invigilator.

The text for each question will be heard on the audio file. This transcript matches the recording for this version of the assessment.

The reader, sound operator and/or invigilator must not refer to or use the standard answer booklet during this assessment. Questions have been adapted and re-worded throughout. The audio files are specific to this modified version of the assessment.

Unless stated there is a pause of 20 seconds before an excerpt is played or next question starts. This is to allow the music teacher to re-read questions and possible answers.

Please note for questions 3(c), 3(d), 3(f) a music teacher is required to snap or tap as indicated at appropriate points in the excerpt as detailed on pages 7 and 8 of this transcript.

For question 3 where a music teacher is required to snap or tap, a guide to the music is provided to facilitate this on page 6.

- (a) Listen to this excerpt. Select **one** of the following four concepts to describe what you hear.



- (a) Name the key of this excerpt.
- (b) Name an Italian term to indicate the tempo and describe where this would be placed in the music.
- (c) During the third playing your teacher will indicate with a snap or tap where bar 3 begins. The first three notes in bar 3 are missing. Give the letter names of these three crotchets.
- (d) During the fourth playing your teacher will indicate with a snap or a tap where bar 6 begins. Name the interval between the first two notes of bar 6.
- (e) The music has a repeat back to the beginning. During the fifth playing you should decide how many complete bars are heard before the music repeats.
- (f) Name the cadence in the final two bars. Your teacher will indicate with a snap or tap where the second last bar begins.

There will now be a pause of 2 minutes.

There is a pause of 2 minutes.

The music will be played six more times with a pause of 45 seconds between playings and a pause of 3 minutes before the next question starts. During the next six playings you should complete your answers (a) to (f).
