Choose **one** of the following two scenarios.

SCENARIO 1: Society

You went to France to stay with the family of your exchange partner. On your return you have been asked to write an account in **French** of your experience for your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where exactly you went in France **and** how you travelled there
- how you got on with the French family
- what you thought about the family's house
- what you did during your stay with the family
- what you thought of the meals you ate
- how this experience will benefit you in the future.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.

OR

SCENARIO 2: Employability

You went to a French-speaking country to do voluntary work. On your return you are asked to write an account in **French** of your experience for your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- who you went with **and** where exactly you went
- why you decided to take part
- what type of work you had to do
- how you got on with the people you met
- what you did in your free time
- whether you would recommend this type of work to other young people.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.
