Choose **one** of the following two scenarios.

SCENARIO 1: Society

Last year you went on holiday to Germany with your family. You stayed in a holiday cottage. You write a report in **German** about your trip for the foreign language section of your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- how you travelled **and** what the cottage was like
- what you did during your stay
- how you got on with your family
- what opportunities you had to use your German
- what you thought of staying in the countryside
- whether you would recommend a holiday in Germany.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.

OR

SCENARIO 2: Learning

Last year you spent some time at a school/college in Hamburg as part of an exchange programme. On your return to school/college in Scotland, your teacher asked you to write in **German** about your trip.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- how you travelled **and** what the journey was like
- what the school/college was like
- what clubs you took part in
- how you got on with the other students
- what you thought of the food in the canteen
- whether or not you would recommend an exchange programme.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.
