**SCENARIO 1: Culture**

You should write approximately 150–180 words.

**SCENARIO 2: Employability**

You have been asked to write a report in **German** about your trip for your school/college magazine.

**You must include** the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- how you travelled **and** what the journey was like
- what your duties were in the hotel
- how you got on with your boss/colleagues
- what you liked/disliked about the job
- how you spent your free time at the weekend
- whether you would recommend a summer job in Germany.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.
