Choose one of the following two scenarios.

SCENARIO 1: Society

Last year you took part in a student exchange programme in Germany where you stayed with a German family. You decide to write about your experience, in **German**, for the language section of your school/college website.

You must include the following information **and you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where exactly the host family lived **and** what the journey there was like
- how well you got on with your exchange partner
- what you did one evening
- your opinion of the food you ate
- what you will do to stay in touch with the family
- in what ways you benefitted from the experience.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.

OR

SCENARIO 2: Culture

Last year you went to a sports camp in Germany. You decide to write about your experience, in **German**, for the language section of your school/college website.

You must include the following information **and you should try to add** other relevant details:

- what the journey was like **and** what the accommodation was like
- what you liked/disliked about the sports camp
- friends you made during your trip
- what you did in your free time
- if you would recommend the experience to others
- whether or not you will return next year.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.
