SCENARIO 1: Employability

- what you thought of the area where you stayed

You should write approximately 150–180 words.

SCENARIO 2: Society

Last year, you spent two weeks in a German-speaking country where you stayed with an exchange partner and their family. You have been asked to write about your experience, in **German**, for the language section of your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where the family lived **and** how you travelled there
- what your exchange partner's family were like
- what you did during your stay
- what you thought of the food you tried
- what souvenirs you bought
- if you would recommend such an experience to others.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.
