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
Question 4

The first excerpt 'He's So Fine' was composed by Ronnie Mack for the group The Chiffons in 1962.

The second excerpt 'My Sweet Lord' was composed by George Harrison in 1970.

Musically there is a strong resemblance between 'My Sweet Lord' and 'He's So Fine'. Ronnie Mack's publisher, Bright Tunes Music Corporation, filed an intellectual property suit in February 1971 in the same year that saw 'My Sweet Lord' become the largest selling single in the UK. The court hearing went to trial in 1976.

After the trial, the judge ruled that Harrison was guilty of *'subconscious plagiarism'* and Harrison was ordered to pay Bright Tunes Music Corporation \$1,599,987.


