SCENARIO 1: Society

SCENARIO 2: Employability

Last year you spent four weeks working in a hotel in Pakistan. On your return you have been asked to write an account in **Urdu** of your experience for your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where the hotel was located **and** what it was like
- what you liked/disliked about the job
- how you got on with your colleagues
- what the weather was like
- what you did in your free time
- whether you would recommend working abroad to others.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.
