Choose one of the following two scenarios.

SCENARIO 1: Learning

You have recently returned from a school/college exchange visit to Pakistan. You have been asked to write a report, in **Urdu**, for the languages page of your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where you went to in Pakistan **and** how you got there
- what your daily routine was in school/college day
- what you thought of the food choices in the school/college
- what other activities you took part in, in the evenings or weekends
- what you did to improve your language skills
- whether you would recommend this type of visit to other language students.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.

OR

SCENARIO 2: Culture

Recently, you took part in a local festival while on holiday in Pakistan. You have been asked to write about your experience, in **Urdu**, for the language section of your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where exactly the festival was **and** how you got there
- what activities you took part in during the festival
- what you enjoyed the most at the festival
- what you thought about the lifestyle in Pakistan
- in what way you practised Urdu during your trip
- whether you would recommend this kind of experience.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.
