Why deliver SQA Advanced Qualifications?

SQA Advanced Qualifications are short-cycle Higher Education qualifications developed in partnership with colleges, universities and industry and specifically designed to meet the requirements of education professionals and the skills needs of employers.

SQA Advanced Certificates and Diplomas are education pathways at Level 4 and 5 enabling students to progress onto further study or directly into employment.

Our Advanced Qualifications are recognised and valued by our network of university progression partners in the UK and beyond allowing progression to a related undergraduate degree.



How do SQA Advanced Qualifications work?

SQA Advanced Certificates and SQA Advanced Diplomas are made up of unit credits (one credit represents approximately 40 hours of timetabled learning and 40 hours of self-guided learning and study):

- SQA Advanced Certificates are made up of 96 SCQF credit points, at SCQF level 7, and usually take one year to complete
- SQA Advanced Diplomas are made up of 240 SCQF credit points, at SCQF level 8, and usually take two years to complete
