➤ SQA Advanced Certificates and Diplomas

SQA Advanced Qualifications are internationally recognised higher education qualifications at certificate and diploma level. They provide students with the theoretical knowledge and practical skills such as information technology, communication, and problem solving that a university or employer would expect them to have. They have been developed to meet the skills needs of employers and the requirements of education professionals.

Typically, an SQA Advanced Certificate is equivalent to the first year of a degree and an SQA Advanced Diploma is equivalent to the first two years of a degree. The SQA Advanced Diploma enables advanced entry into many undergraduate degree programmes in SQA's partner universities and higher education institutions.

➤ Practical Learning

SQA Advanced Qualifications aim to develop the high-level transferable skills and academic knowledge required for degree study or work. They use practical approaches to learning, with study methods including project and assignment work, group work, presentations, and case studies.

➤ Assessment

SQA Advanced Qualifications use a variety of assessment methods, such as an exam, essay, project, investigation and/ or a practical assignment. Assessment is quality assured through internal verification using an institution's own staff and external verification, using SQA subject experts from the education sector.

➤ Certification

On successful completion of an SQA Advanced Qualification students will receive:

- An SQA certificate with a summary of attainment
- A listing of all the units passed and the grade awarded

SQA Advanced Certificates are made up of 96 SCQF credit points at SCQF level 7. SQA Advanced Diplomas are made up of 240 SCQF credit points at SCQF level 8. Find out more about the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF) in the following section.

➤ International Recognition

SQA's Advanced Qualifications are aligned to the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF). The SCQF is a way of comparing qualifications and making the relationship between qualifications clearer. It covers achievements such as those from school, college, university, and many work-based qualifications. The SCQF also illustrates the relationships between Scottish qualifications and those in the rest of the UK, Europe and beyond, which can clarify international progression routes and credit transfer.


SQA is also a member of the Federation of Awarding Bodies and the Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ). The Federation of Awarding

Bodies is the collective voice of the UK's world-class qualifications and assessments industry. JCQ is a membership organisation representing the largest national awarding bodies offering qualifications in the UK.

SQA's Advanced Qualifications have also been evaluated by The Academic Credentials Evaluation Institute (ACEI), World Education Services (WES) and UK ENIC. This analysis provides further understanding of the value of SQA qualifications, the calibre of those who have achieved them, and how they compare with programs of study offered in universities and colleges around the world.
