Semester Hours of Credit: Unless otherwise noted, ACEI measures and reports the quantity of academic work completed at the post-secondary/tertiary level in another country in terms of semester hours of credit. An academic period within a semester system usually consists of between 14 to 18 weeks. One calendar year can be divided into two semesters and a summer session equal to one-half of a semester. In the United States, one year of full-time academic work represents a total of 30 to 32 semester hours of credit. Usually one credit hour represents one hour each week for a semester, or approximately 16 classroom contacts.

Grades and Grade Point Average (GPA): Grades/marks/final examination results are converted into equivalent U.S. grades of A, B, C, D, F. The GPA is a measurement of the quality of a student's performance and is determined by dividing the total number of grade points earned by the number of credit hours attempted, including failures. The GPA calculation does not include grades of incomplete, pass, or withdrawn. Grades & Quality Points Per Credit Hour: A+/A = 4.00; A- = 3.70; B+ = 3.30; B = 3.00; B- = 2.70; C + = 2.30; C = 2.00; C- = 1.70; D = 1.00; F = 0.00; P/Pass = indicates satisfactory completion of coursework where no letter grade is given but represents equivalent to a grade of C or higher, however, carries no quality point.
