The GPA is a measurement of the quality of a student's performance and is determined by dividing the total number of grade points earned by the number of credit hours attempted, including failures. The GPA calculation does not include grades of incomplete, pass, or withdrawn. Grades & Quality Points Per Credit Hour: A+/A = 4.00; A- = 3.70; B+ = 3.30; B = 3.00; B- = 2.70; C+ = 2.30; C = 2.00; C- = 1.70; D = 1.00; F = 0.00; P/Pass = indicates satisfactory completion of coursework where no letter grade is given but represents equivalent to a grade of C or higher, however, carries no quality point.
