General Update

Qualification Verification Summary Reports

Qualification Verification Summary Reports (QVSRs) for Accounting, Administration, Information Technology, Business and Financial Services are expected to be published on the respective HN subject pages towards the end of the year. The purpose of these reports is to provide a summary of key points from external verification of each subject over the previous year. Centres may find it useful to refer to these reports for examples of good practice and areas where development may be needed.

HN Network Support Events

We continue to receive positive feedback regarding the annual Network Support Events. Delegates highlighted the importance of being able to meet and network with fellow practitioners. We intend to host Network Events for Accounting, Business and Administration and Information Technology in early 2020. Suggestions from delegates via feedback forms will be taken into account when devising the programme. Centres will be notified of the dates and process for booking places towards the end of this year.

HN Survey

The 2018/19 annual survey is now closed and we thank all of those who took time to complete these. The surveys provide valuable feedback from both practitioners and learners, and are used to inform future qualification developments and projects. The

responses will be summarised and presented for discussion at the next Qualification Support Team (QST) meeting in November 2019.

Group Award Specifications (Arrangements Documents) are updated annually to reflect any changes to the Group Award frameworks and/or content. Centres should ensure the most up to version for each Group Award framework is being used. These documents are found on each of the HN subject pages.

Subject Updates

HN Accounting

A new standard (IRFS 16 Leases) affecting the treatment of leases came into effect on 1 January 2019. This change mainly affects the Units **Accounting for Specialised Transactions (HC44 35)**, **Financial Reporting and Analysis (HC43 35)** and **Accounting: Graded Unit 3 (F8KG 35)**. However, there are also minor implications for **Business Taxation (J0LY 35)** and **Auditing (FN11 35)**. For session 2019/20, centres can use the ASPs as they stand or update to reflect the changes.

Exemptions

Details of exemptions from some of the Association of Accounting Technicians' (AAT) qualifications/units is now included in an Appendix in the Group Award Specification (Arrangements Document).

Consultation

SQA will be carrying out a consultation between September and December 2019 to appraise the HNC and HND Accounting Group Awards. This is intended to identify where updates may be needed to ensure they continue to remain current, reflect modern practice and the challenges faced by the accounting sector.

Feedback from centres on unit content and assessment will be welcomed. Centres will be contacted for their input in due course.

Accounting: Graded Unit 3 (F8KG 35)

The integrity of the Assessment Support Pack (ASP) for Accounting: Graded Unit 3 (F8KG35VAEX002) has been compromised and this has been removed from SQA's secure website. A new ASP will be available by the end of December 2019.

HN Administration and Information Technology

Graded Unit 1 HH9M 34

We are currently revising Administration and Information Technology Graded Unit 1 SOLAR assessment questions. Two new fixed SOLAR assessments will be created with hard copy equivalents. The new assessments should be available early in 2020.

Digital Technologies for Administrators HH82 34

SOLAR team are in process of converting the recently published Digital Technologies for Business paper ASPs to a SOLAR version. These will replace the current SOLAR assessments for this unit when available.

HN Administration and Information Technology G9M7 15 and G9M8 16 end dates

HNC Administration and Information Technology (G9M7 15) and HND Administration and Information (G9M8 16) Group Awards ended on 1st August 2019. From this date new learners must be enrolled for the current Group Awards:

HND Administration and Information Technology Group Award Code: **GM0Y 16**

Formative Assessments

We have moved Units which have now finished into the HNC/D Administration and Information Technology formative assessments area of the SQA secure site. These may be used as formative assessments. It is the centre's responsibility to ensure that summative assessment meet the requirements of the current Unit specification.

HN Business

Review

A limited review of HNC and HND Business will commence in September. The review will be informed by the consultation carried out in late 2018, and the recent annual surveys.

The scope of the review will include the following aims:

- Update content
- Increase flexibility of assessment
- Improve flexibility of the qualification structure

This will involve the development of new units, review of some existing units and potentially a reduction in the mandatory content of one or both Group Awards.

Due to timescales, the review will proceed on the basis of existing Design Principles rather than as part of the forthcoming HN Next-Gen Pilot.

With the aim of increasing flexibility of assessment, consideration will be given to embedding some of the assessment approaches used in the HN Enhancements Pilot in some units.
