Further to our meeting of yesterday, I thought it might be helpful to drop you a note of what we agreed as next steps.

First of all, we are agreed that a late Easter and associated changes to Easter holidays in 2025 (and 2026) have prompted the concern. We outlined the extensive engagement undertaken this year on the exam timetable, including with SLS colleagues, and the current version of the timetable has been developed after careful consideration of coincident exams, learner workload, and the implications for assessment arrangements. These considerations, along with religious observance, bank holidays and the time needed to mark and quality assure courses, has resulted in the optimal timetable starting one day later than this year on 23 April.

During the meeting, Jean Blair offered to explore options with you in re-modelling the timetable to start later than 23 April. However, we highlighted that increases in coincident exams and the number of exams which learners take over a day or week will likely be a concern.

highlighted a number of wider issues, including UCAS UK-wide deadlines, assessment burden and priority appeals deadlines. We are happy to have wider conversations about these issues, but we also need to be realistic about next year. I am also very conscious that teachers want to take a well-deserved holiday over the summer, so extending marking or bringing forward priority appeals is not possible. We agreed that a system-wide conversation about Easter holidays in 2026 is necessary – and there should be a wider conversation with the Scottish Government, COSLA and ADES.

To conclude, Martin Ingram will be in touch to explore what other options may be available. As highlighted above, any changes would need to be carefully considered and have system-wide support.

I hope this is helpful.

Timing of the 2025 and 2026 SQA Exam Diets

I hope this finds you well. The SQA diet is in full flow now and all seems to be going well. Not sure if the Music Technology exam went Ok, as I saw something on Twitter/X about it! I've had no complaints at all – so far- about the diet. Fingers crossed this continues!

However, some SLS Head Teacher members have raised a concern about the timing of the 2025 and 2026 Diets, which I feel I need to share with you. For 2025, SQA has sent notice that the exams are due to start on Wednesday 23 April 2025. The exam dates have crept forward in recent years and the diet has grown in length. Whilst this year's diet commenced on Monday 22 April 2024, the vast majority of schools had one week back with the senior school which is important to get some young people back on track with work and do last-minute revision.

Next session in 2025 the holiday starts on Monday 7 April – and this means a return to school on Monday 21 April in most authorities. However, this being Easter Monday, we return on Tuesday 22 April. SQA exams start the next day on Wednesday 23 April. So, schools will have one day of pupils back in school, and it is unlikely most young people will be in. This is a concern as some young people definitely require the routine of school to get ready for exams. Whilst I appreciate that putting together an exam timetable is a complex task, it is extremely worrying that no account has been taken of the fact that young people will not be with their teachers for the crucial two weeks prior to their exams starting. This will, no doubt, have a negative impact on their overall attainment and performance.

In addition, schools will need to have the last day for S6 on Friday 4 April, before the Easter holidays. (Whether we like it or not, that is now a "rite of passage", and it is not as simple as saying, just cancel it).

None of this is ideal for any school and the concerns for the following year, 2026, are greater still. Easter is at the start of the holiday so we will be off school from Good Friday, 3 April, and start back on Monday 20 April. If the timetable for 2025 is anything to go by, SQA may look to start the 2026 exams on Tuesday 21 April. This is a real problem. It almost feels like we are there to serve the SQA rather than the SQA is there to work with us to meet the needs of young people.

In addition, the issue of having any sort of S6 last day before the holiday is a headache for Catholic Schools in particular as they should not be having anything of that nature on Holy Thursday, 2 April, or really during Holy Week, the entire last week of term.

However, this earlier starting date is an issue for everyone, as coming straight back into the exams is not conducive to good attainment. We also fear that an extended break away from their teachers will disadvantage the most disadvantaged candidates disproportionately, particularly in schools where there are exceptionally high levels of deprivation and the consequent lack of educational support in many households.

Additional to this is the fact that all school deadlines will need to reflect this lack of teaching weeks, post Easter. Whilst this might make the lives of SQA easier, it does the opposite for schools and the most important stakeholders – our young people – who will be under significant pressure to complete courses and then revise without the support of their expert teachers.

Finally, this puts undue pressure on teaching staff to ensure that there is provision over the Easter holiday for our senior phase pupils. Many schools offer Easter revision classes, but I fear this change of teaching contact after the holiday will make this feel more compulsory, not something we wish. Teachers across Scotland work incredibly hard all year long but especially in the January to March term and this change will have a direct impact on their capacity to take a much-needed holiday at Easter.

Either of the following two proposals would solve the issue:

SQA exam diet is ideally pushed back to Monday 28 April 2025 starts and starts on Monday 27 April 2026

or

We dispense with the first two full weeks of April holiday and have the 2026 holiday from Monday 30 March 2026 until Friday 10 April returning on Monday 13 April. The middle weekend would be Easter weekend. That would be an issue for the 32 Local Authorities, and some may already have taken this course, if they have agreed their holiday dates.

This issue is a significant headache for all schools and a decision which appears to have been taken to meet the needs of the SQA with no regard for the practicalities of school life. SQA are providing a service to Scottish schools. Of late it feels to many of my members, that we are at your mercy. However, I am hoping you can help resolve this issue through the first option! I look forward to hearing from you. I have cc'd

into this email, as she may also be able to help resolve this issue.
