<b>You need to know and understand</b>		<b>Evidence</b>
Evidence of knowledge and understanding should be collected during observation of performance in the workplace. Where it cannot be collected by observing performance, other assessment methods should be used.		
K1	The different methods that can be used to minimise environmental damage.	
K2	How to choose the most suitable materials and equipment, given the nature of the work activity, and its potential impact on the environment.	
K3	The different types of environmental damage.	
K4	The organisational and legislative requirements relating to environmental damage.	
K5	Types of damage that may occur, the impact these can have on the environment, and what corrective actions can be taken.	
K6	How to dispose of waste in ways that minimise the risk to the environment.	
K7	Reporting procedures for environmental incidents.
