



## GR9V 22 SVQ in Leather, Sewn Products or Textiles Manufacturing at SCQF level 5

**SCQF overall credit:** Minimum 31 Maximum 38

**This SVQ comprises three pathways: leather, sewn products and textiles**

To attain the qualification candidates are required to complete 6 units in total from their chosen pathway. This comprises 2 mandatory units and 4 optional units.

### Leather pathway:

- ◆ Mandatory – 2 units required
- ◆ Options Group A – 1 unit required
- ◆ Options Group B – 3 units required

### Sewn Products pathway:

- ◆ Mandatory – 2 units required
- ◆ Options Group A – 1 unit required
- ◆ 3 units in total must be selected from across Options Groups B and C
  - Group B - minimum of one, maximum of two units required
  - Group C - minimum of one, maximum of two units required

### Textiles pathway:

- ◆ Mandatory – 2 units required
- ◆ Options Group A – 1 unit required
- ◆ Options Group B – 3 units required

Please note the table below shows the SSC identification codes listed alongside the corresponding SQA unit codes. It is important that the SQA unit codes are used in all your recording documentation and when your results are communicated to SQA.
