All practical assessment **must be observed directly, face-to-face** by the assessor.

Reflexology: Advanced (HL90 35)

Outcomes 2 to 4

Demonstrate by practical assessment on a minimum of **six** individual treatments and **two** case studies of **six** weeks duration.

For each of the **two** case studies, one of the client's conditions should be identified, researched further and a rationale for the treatment plan identified and explained along with an evaluation of the effectiveness of the treatment.

All practical assessment **must be observed directly, face-to-face** by the assessor.
