##### Outcome 4

Assess this outcome during a live performance. You can reduce the production time to a minimum of 20 minutes. Each candidate must perform for a minimum of 5 minutes, to demonstrate the required skills and techniques.

To help centres facilitate smaller groups, the performance can be an abridged version of a play, for example one act or scene from a full play, and this can be repeated.
